When in addition to the ordinary evening call an employee takes part in an intermediate call commencing at between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. the employer shall pay to such employee a meal allowance of \$5.30 for his or her evening meal and shall also provide tea and coffee or the ingredients and facilities to make and serve same.
