Casual Employees

A casual employee for working ordinary time shall be paid per hour one thirty-eighth of the weekly wage prescribed by this award for the class of work performed plus 15 per centum.

NOTE: Casual employees are entitled to payment of pro-rata annual leave pursuant to the provisions of the Annual Holidays Act (1944). The calculation is based upon 1/12 of the casual hourly rate for all ordinary hours (excluding overtime) worked by a casual employee during each engagement.
